**NOTICE OF MOTION**

TO: *The Members of Campbell River T.V. Association*

**TAKE NOTICE** that an application will be made by the Petitioner to the presiding Judge in Chambers at the Courthouse, at 500-13th Avenue, Campbell River, British Columbia, at a date and time to be set seeking the directions of the Court with respect to the following question:

1. Should the liquidator distribute the sum of \$3,375.00 to each corporate member of the Campbell River T.V. Association as part of an interim distribution of the assets of the Society?

The Applicant will rely on:

1. Section 290(K) of the Business Corporations Act;

At the hearing of the application, the applicant will rely on the following Affidavit and such other documents as presented by counsel for the Petitioner:

- Order of this Honourable Court made May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2009;
- Affidavit #1 of Chris McPhedran sworn August 28<sup>th</sup>, 2009;

and the pleadings and proceedings had and taken herein.

The applicant estimates that the application will take thirty (30) minutes.

If you wish to receive notice of the time and date of the hearing or to respond to the application, you must, within the proper time for response,

- (a) deliver to the applicant
  - (i) 2 copies of a response in Form 124, and
  - (ii) 2 copies of each of the affidavits and other documents, not already in the court file, on which you intend to rely at the hearing, and
- (b) deliver to every other party of record
  - (i) one copy of a response in Form 124, and
  - (ii) one copy of each affidavit and other document, not already in the court file, on which you intend to rely at the hearing.


**TIME FOR RESPONSE**

If the application is for a final judgment under Rule 18A, the response must be delivered on or before the 11th day after the delivery to you of the notice of motion.

In all other cases, the response must be delivered on or before the 8th day after the later of

- (a) the last date fixed for entry of appearance by you, and
- (b) the date on which the notice of motion was delivered to you.
